

## Strategic Goals



- \* Continue to develop Ambassador program






### Holy Redeemer School Assessment Results

Assessments used at Holy Redeemer include the projects and tests provided by the classroom teacher, Title I testing, and the NWEA tests given to students in grades K-8. All grades take a Math test and a Reading test. The Language Usage test begins in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade and we administer the Science test in 4<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
